 - 09.00 A fourty-year old female. Short of breath, acute radiating pain in the chest. Suspicion of (2) . Hospitalised for examination.
 - 10.15 A twenty-six year old pregnant woman. Pains in the lower abdomen area. Vaginal haemorrhage. Suspicion of (3) . Hospitalised.
 - 10.15 A fifteen-year old male. Walking problem after a fall. Pain in the lower part of the left leg. Diagnose: shinbone (4) . Plaster put on.
 - 11.10 A sixty-year old male. Heavy smoker. Breathing difficulty, bad cough, mucus. Suspicion: (5) . Hospitalised for examination.
 - 11.45 A fifty-five year old male. Sharp pain in the right upper section of abdomen in the bladder area. Vomiting and nausea. Suspicion: (6) Hospitalised for examination.
 - 11.55 A seventeen-year old female. Sore throat, swallowing problems, swollen glands, fever and chills. Diagnose: (7) . Antibiotics prescribed.
 - 12.10 A fourty-five male. Burning abdominal pain below the rib cage. Complaints of a rapid weight loss and a permanent feeling of full stomach . Suspicion: (8) . Hospitalised for examination.
